The proximity to the music and the musicians proves to be an intimate experience where attendees can see the musician's expressions, hear the instruments themselves without passing though a sound system, or watch the interactions between the conductor and the performers. This free concert is a perfect time for young children to see and hear symphony music in a fun and casual setting where the kids are welcome to march around, sing along, and dance.

The "I Love America Celebration" begins at 9:30 am with free admission to the George Bush Library and Museum. At 5:30 pm Concessions and Games will be available for families along with other live entertainment and activities and free parking is available at Fan Field, the gravel parking lot on Research Parkway on the Texas A&M University campus.
