

Dear Music Educator!

The Brazos Valley Symphony Orchestra (BVSU) and Friends Association of the Symphony Orchestra (FASO) are proud to present the 23<sup>rd</sup> annual Brazos Valley Youth Concerto Competition! The competition is scheduled to take place on Sunday, November 12, 2023, at 3 p.m. at First Methodist Church in Bryan, TX. The deadline for entries is Friday, September 29, 2023. There is no charge to enter the competition.

Tracy and Tamara Carter have provided long-term funding to establish The Tracy and Tamara Carter Youth Concerto Endowed Scholarship Fund. Thanks to their generosity, the winner of the competition will receive a \$1000 Scholarship to assist with education expenses at a university of their choosing. The winner does not need to be a music major to qualify.

The competition is open to all music students who will be in public or private school in the fall, as well as students who are homeschooled. Past winners have been as young as 9 years old up through seniors in high school and competed on string, woodwind, brass, percussion, and piano.

Entrants must submit their entry form and audio file submission no later than Friday, September 29, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. They can submit a performance of any movement from a concerto or suitable piece for solo instrument and orchestra from the standard orchestral repertoire. Unaccompanied repertoire is not acceptable. Please refer to the rule sheet for further information on how to identify their audio file.

Entries will be judged blindly by Dr. Marcelo Bussiki, music director and conductor of the Brazos Valley Symphony Orchestra, and a panel of BVSU musicians who will select three to five finalists to perform in person on Sunday, November 12, 2023.

While not required, students are strongly encouraged to have an accompanist on their entry. They will be required to perform in the finals with a professional pianist to be provided by FASO. Rehearsal times will be scheduled with each finalist prior to the event.

The finals will be judged by a separate panel of talented musicians. First through third place finalists will receive a plaque. In addition to the \$1000 scholarship, the first-place winner will be invited to perform with the BVSU at its annual Children's Concert that is scheduled to take place on Monday, February 5, 2024. FASO will also pay the winner's application fee for the prestigious Juanita Miller Concerto Competition hosted in Dallas each January by the Texas Association of Symphony Orchestras.
